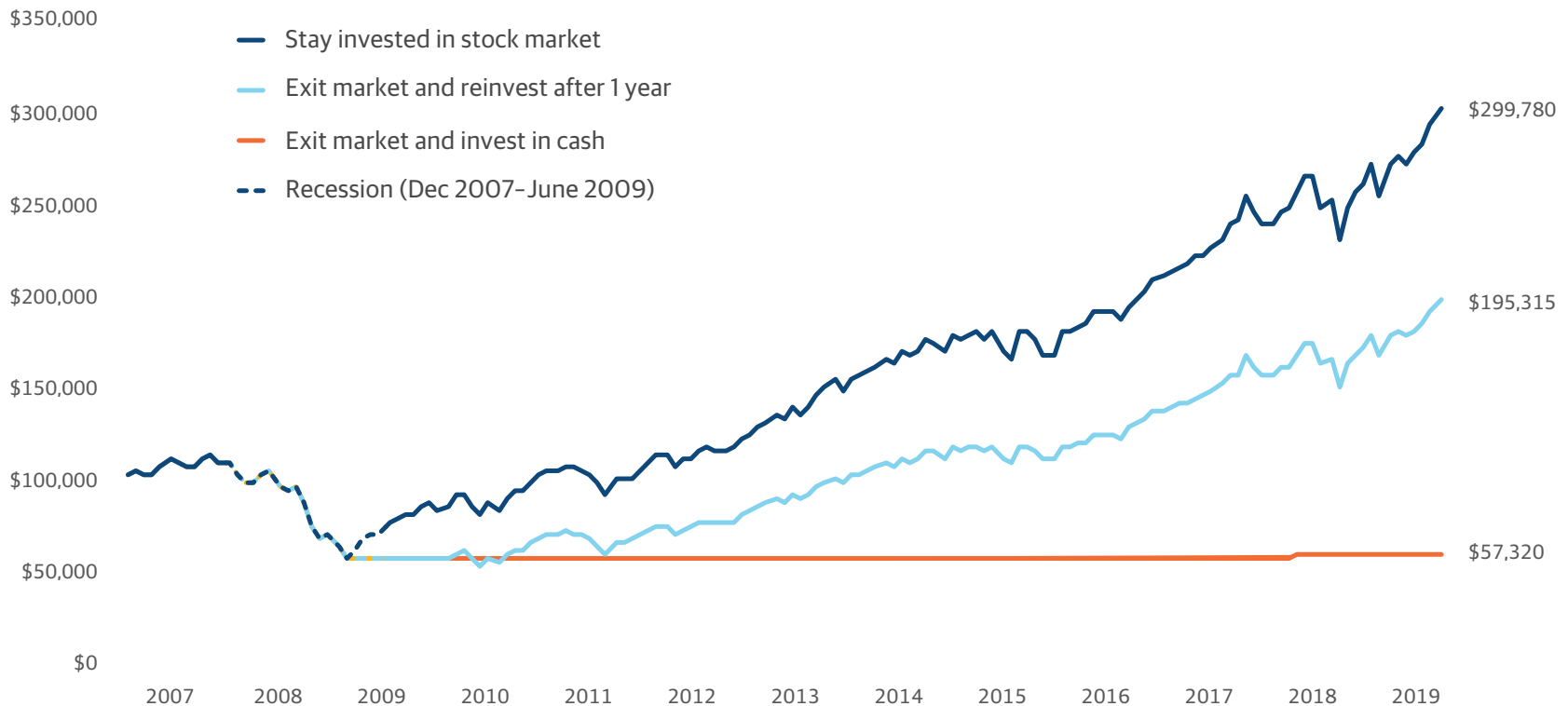


THE IMPORTANCE OF STAYING INVESTED
